

Customer FAQ Update - 21 August 2026

Superbike Factory Limited (In Administration) ("the Company")

This update is for people falling into the following two categories:

Category 1 - You have paid for a Motorcycle but have not received it (**Sold Bikes**); and

Category 2 - You have sold a Motorcycle but have not been paid for it (**Collected Bikes**),
(together, **the Bikes**).

As noted in the update provided on 14 August 2026, the Joint Administrators remain in continued dialogue with the Company's third-party funder regarding which party has title to the Bikes and are working at pace alongside legal advisors to establish the correct ownership position.

The Joint Administrators continue to consider the position as a matter of urgency and hope to convey the outcome as soon as they are able. The Joint Administrators appreciate the effect of this continuing uncertainty, however, they are required to investigate the position and engage in continued dialogue in accordance with their duties as Joint Administrators.

To date the majority of the Bikes were stored securely at the Company's former trading premises. However, due to insufficient funds available in the Company's estate, the Joint Administrators have agreed for the third-party funder to collect and store the Bikes (via third-party collection agents).

To that end, the third-party funder has provided an undertaking to the Joint Administrators that it will safely store, secure and insure the Bikes whilst investigations in relation to ownership and title of the Bikes continues. The undertaking confirms that the third-party funder will not sell the Bikes whilst investigations continue.

The third-party funder continues to fully co-operate with the Joint Administrators and the Company throughout these on-going investigations. If it is determined that ownership of a Bike does not lie with the third-party funder, the undertaking provides that the relevant Bike will be made available to the determined legal owner.

The undertaking also provides that each Bike will be stored separately from other assets while the investigations in relation to title continues.

A further update will be provided in due course.
